Attendance

- GCSE Results 2025
- Results improved for the 3rd year in a row
 - 21% of all grades were 7, 8 or 9
- 75% of students obtained grade 4 or above in English
 and Maths National figure was 65%
 - Sheringham students gained 68 grade 9s

Every student who did not achieve Grade 4 English and Maths had under 90% attendance

90% = 1 day off per fortnight

95% = 1 day off every 4 weeks

Data shows that poor attendance habits that start in Y7 are very difficult to break.
